### NEW PROCESS!

This year student groups must register their intent to post a signboard through an online system. Only one RSVP per group is allowed and the group must be active. There will be a total of 36 spots available for registration on the system, accompanied by a waitlist. More information on this process will be available in the next week in a special email!

## Student Group Re-Registration

It's almost that wonderful time of year again...students purchasing hundreds of dollars worth of books and school supplies, putting on your blue and gold for the first Cal football game, and re-registering your student group with Campus Life & Leadership!

This year we are proud to announce some additions to the registration system that will hopefully make the process a little easier for each student group!

- **Status screens** will now be available for each organization to track the progress they have made in the registration process. One unique feature of the screen is that you will be able to see how many approved signatories your organization has, along with who has and has not completed the orientation quiz.
- Each organization will have the ability to self-select the **group type** (categories) they want to be affiliated with. An additional screen in the registration process will be available for you to choose up to three different categories.

Recruitment**

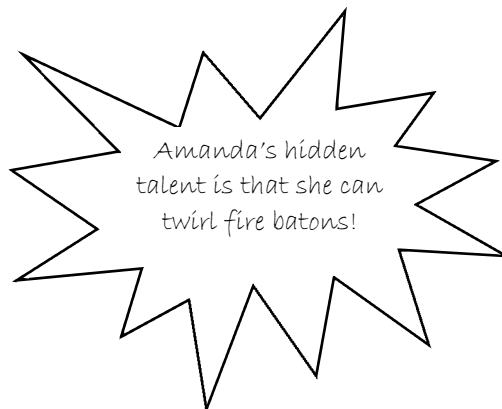

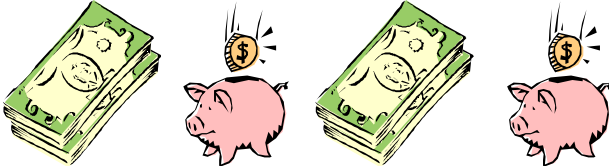


Participants in the Blueprint Leadership Program build Lego structures during a program activity.
